

### **New logo policy and acknowledgement of funding in publications**

The Research Executive Agency (REA) has reminded us of a change in the logo policy of the European Commission. For all new publications, please no longer use the FP7 logo, but only the European flag logo along with the following text:

*“This project has received funding from the European Union’s Seventh Framework Programme for research, technological development and demonstration under grant agreement no. 606713”.*

The BIBAFOODS website has already been modified to comply with the new policy. If you choose, you may still use the Marie Curie Actions logo, and of course you should still use one of the BIBAFOODS logos.

Some of you are already working on your first publications, and for work which is a result of BIBAFOODS funding, please remember to add the following sentence in the acknowledgement section:

*“The research leading to these results has received funding from the People Programme (Marie Curie Actions) of the European Union’s Seventh Framework Programme FP7/2007-2013/ under REA grant agreement n° 606713”.*

The phrasing of funding acknowledgement can be found in Annex II of the Grant Agreement (more specifically: II.29, 4, p. 30-31).

### **Publications**

According to our consortium agreement, any project partners involved in a planned publication should be **notified at least 45 days before** the publication date – and any objections to a planned publication must be made within 30 days after receipt of the notification. Check out section 8.3.1 of the consortium agreement, which is available in the BIBAFOODS Sharepoint group. You can also use the BIBAFOODS Sharepoint group to exchange manuscripts in preparation, as the group is only open to BIBAFOODS participants.

BIBAFOODS must keep a record of all publications from the project, including:

- Peer reviewed publications
- Papers in proceedings of a conference/workshop
- Article/section in an edited book or book series
- Theses/dissertations
- University publications/scientific monographs

Therefore, once your paper is published, please provide the following information to Henriette ([henha@food.ku.dk](mailto:henha@food.ku.dk)):

Authors  
Journal  
Volume/issue  
Date of publication  
URL (if available)  
Relevant pages  
Open access status (yes/no)

The list of publications must be included in the final report to REA.

### **Second Annual School – new dates**

### Progress meeting, Mid-Term Review & next Supervisory Board meeting

Immediately after the second annual school there will be a **progress meeting**. You should consider this as a preparation for the Mid-Term Review, and all fellows must give the presentations they have to offer at the Mid-Term Review; the BIBAFOODS fellows should take significant comments from the progress meeting participants into account when finalizing their presentations for the Mid-Term Review. Our REA project officer will be present at the Mid-Term Review, but not at the progress meeting. The Mid-Term Review is **mandatory** for all project partners, including fellows (Grant Agreement, Article II.3.h).

20 November 2015: Mid-Term Review  
(presentations by fellows)

All fellows must complete a **fellow questionnaire** in the Participant Portal (the on-line reporting tool for EU-projects) at least 14 days before the date of the Mid-Term review, i.e. no later than 5 November. You will receive instructions about how to do this during the autumn.

The Supervisory Board meeting – for Supervisory Board members only – will be held on the last day of the annual school. All meetings during 18-20 November will be held at University of Alcalá in Madrid.
